SAFE & SANE FIREWORKS BOOTH LOCATIONS

The 2024 Safe & Sane Fireworks booth locations have been announced. The Dixon Municipal Code allows for the sale of safe and sane fireworks from June 28th to July 4th. The code allows for the possession, and use of safe and sane fireworks during a specified time from June 28th through July 6th of each calendar year.

Fireworks that explode, shoot through the air, move along the ground, including skyrockets, bottle rockets and firecrackers of all types are never permitted.

A violation of the Fireworks Ordinance is punishable by the issuance of an administrative citation with an accompanying administrative fine up to \$1,000.

END OF SCHOOL YEAR SAFETY

Attention Dixon Community: Stay Alert and Safe This Summer!

As the school year comes to an end, we anticipate an increase in children and teenagers enjoying their summer break throughout our neighborhoods. The Dixon Police Department would like to remind all residents to be extra vigilant and mindful of our young community members who will be out and about at various times of the day.

Increased Presence of Children and Teens

With more children walking, biking, and playing in residential areas, it's crucial to drive cautiously and be prepared to stop for pedestrians. Slow down near schools, parks, and crosswalks, as children might be less aware of traffic dangers.

E-Scooter Safety Reminder

Electric scooters have become a popular mode of transportation for our youth, but they also come with significant safety risks. We've seen several recent incidents involving scooter vs. vehicle collisions, where none of the riders were wearing helmets. E-scooter riders must follow the same traffic laws as bicycles, including obeying traffic signals and signs.

Relevant California Law on E-Scooters (CVC §21235)

- **Helmet Requirement:** Persons under 18 years of age must wear a properly fitted and fastened bicycle helmet.
- **Valid Driver's License:** Riders must possess a valid driver's license or instruction permit.
- **Road Usage:** E-scooters must be ridden on the road or in bike lanes and are not permitted on sidewalks.
- **Speed Limit:** The maximum speed for an e-scooter is 15 mph.

Community Involvement

We urge parents to talk to their children about the importance of e-scooter safety and to ensure they follow the laws. Residents should also report any unsafe riding behavior to the police. Together, we can protect our children and make our community safer for everyone.

WATER RATE ADVISORY AD HOC COMMITTEE MAKES RECOMMENDATION TO CITY COUNCIL


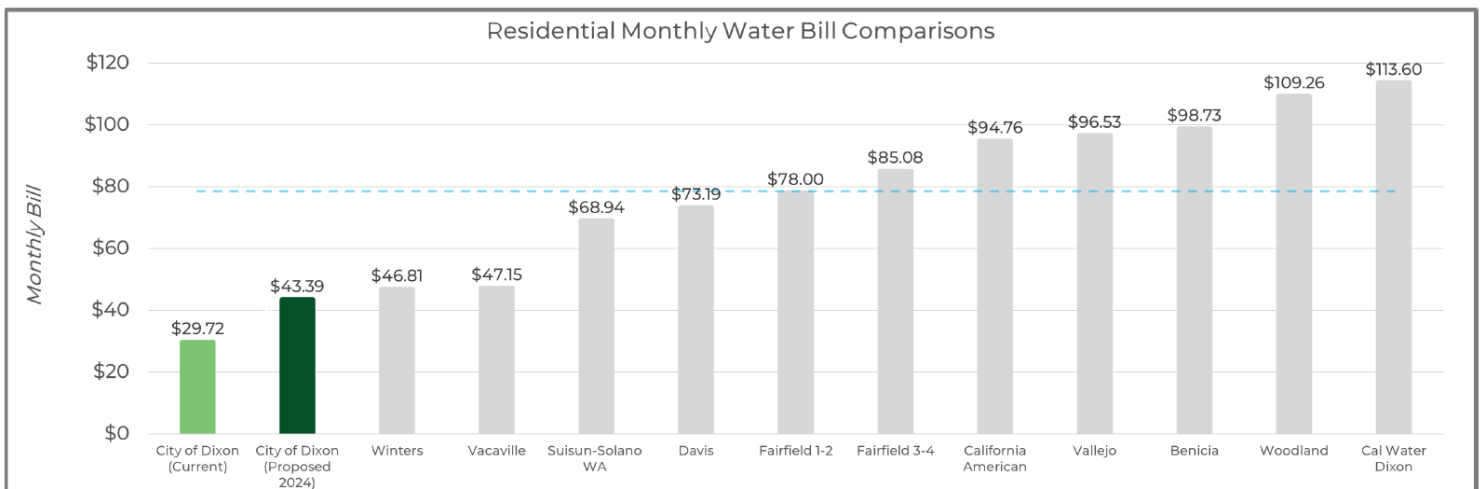
In February 2023, the Dixon City Council established the Water Rate Advisory Ad Hoc Committee (Committee). The goal of the Committee was to make a recommendation to the City Council regarding appropriate new water rates.

The Committee worked for over a year to review the financial and operational history of the water system and understand the system's needs. The City held twelve public Committee meetings, a public workshop and answered 42 questions submitted by the public.


In April 2024, the Committee voted to recommend a five-year rate schedule that will meet the critical and near-term needs of the water system. These increases are necessary to maintain a safe and reliable drinking water system and fund necessary capital improvement projects. The projects include well, tank and other system upgrades, but do not include treatment upgrades, including for Chromium 6.

On May 7, 2024, City Council voted to support the Committee's recommendation. The rate study report and all Committee presentations, including a list of capital projects that this rate adjustment will fund, are available online at <https://www.cityofdixon.us/watercommittee>.

The current City of Dixon water rates were adopted in 2013. Even with the proposed 2024 rate adjustment, City of Dixon rates will remain the lowest in the region. The chart below shows the average monthly water bill for residential customers in the region. The average residential water bill is 12 units of water use and a ¾" meter fee.



Your City utility bill includes water and sewer charges. The proposed adjustments only apply to the water portion of your bill.



The current water rates were adopted in 2013. Since then, construction costs have increased 49%.
